Pastor's Perspective

May is one of those months that is filled to overflowing with events and celebrations both in the Church and in our family and community life. It is one of those times when we sometimes want to stop the merry go round and get off so that we can catch our breath. One of our celebrations this month is exactly about "catching our breath." That is, it is about catching the "Breath of God."

Pentecost celebrates the gift of the Holy Spirit to those followers of Christ who are open to new life in the power of the Spirit. The word used for "Spirit" in Hebrew is the same word that is used for "Breath." So, let's catch our breath, the breath that gives new life, the breath of God's transforming love through the Holy Spirit poured out upon and within us. In this month of activity, I pray that we will all be borne up by the Spirit of God who sustains us and renews us even in the chaos of our busy lives.

Pentecost, May 20, is the celebration of the birth of the Church as the power of the Holy Spirit is poured out upon the followers of Jesus so that they can proclaim and demonstrate the love of God to the world. We will celebrate Pentecost by welcoming people into the professing membership of the Church through the rite of Confirmation. We will welcome the young people who have been participating in this year's confirmation class. If, in addition, there are any adults who would like to affirm or reaffirm their faith in Jesus Christ and unite with the RiversEdge congregation along with the confirmands, please let me know. Also, if there are any families who would like to have children baptized, this would be an appropriate time.



I have so many things to learn that I don't yet understand.


Teach me things to keep me safe from the dangers everyday.


